#### 11. DEFENCES

CONVOYS. DAIREN to HOKKAI. Nov '39. 41 Rogt on 5 or 6 ships with an escort of 2 or 5 destroyers sailed from DAIREN vin UTINA. Convoy remained at anchor at HAINAN for about a week during which time 40 to 50 vessels assembled. They then proceeded to HOKKAI.

EARLIEU to CHINKAL. Apr 141. SAKURA MARU and 5 or 6 ships escorted by one or two dustroyers. The journey occupied 2 or 3 days.

# 12. ENERY, SUPPLIES

Cocongs 011 TOTAN MARU left MCJI empty for MANILA to loed coconut cil.

Rations At MANBURE each soldier landed with 10 days surply of rice, MISC (been paste) SHOYU (Soy) and cenned goods. At GONA the feed shortene was serious; the daily rice issue being not more than 1 60 (.55 lbs). However, PW asserted they were not reduced to such dire straits as even to consider enting human flesh. He had, moreover, not heard any rumours to this effect.

## 13. MOESLE SET PROPERSHIDA

Conditions in JAPAN FW was in JAPAN in Oct '42 and since that date had not heard from nor written to his people. Thile in FHILIPINE ISLAND he received one comfortive bag. According to FW there was no wer been in JAPAN. Everythis was retioned and there were shortages.

Political Conditions in JATAM IV was not interested in political and sould not say how his fathers voted. Although he thought that were was not a good thing, notation the competent to express an opinion as to elternetive methods of sattling international disputes. PW knew nothing of Communian or of the 25 Feb 105 incident. He had no ideas from the CHIMINGTON inclient or the CHIMINGTON inclient.

Conditions in Fighting Services IV had no idea of the numbers of man mobilized in JAPAN in 2 past 5 years. In his own village of 1500 people, 300 to 400 dead some. Here of his relatives had some active service and he could not say how old scheduntes in the convices had forced. We on one econsism, sustained a slight log wound. "PE" drugs were unknown to PT. Vitumen teblets/were issued.

#### 4. ALLIED FORCES

Air Attacks 12 to 1: Dec 42. Allied directs bembed convoy consisting of K. ELUMO and 4 destroyers between RABAUL and MAMPLES. Although A/C attacked 4 or 5 times the destroyers were not demand as the A/C kept at a high altitude.
