1. PREAMBLE

This PW volunteered in the Japanese Army at the age of 17 and has had 20 years of service, rising to the rank of Warrant Officer. Possessing a good military bearing he answered all questions frankly and without hesitation. He has considerable military knowledge and is highly intelligent.

2. BIOGEOLOGY

Personal History Volunteered Dec 1919 at the age of 17 and attached to 15 Inf Regt, 14 Div, at TAKASAKI. In '27 went with his Regt to MANCHERIA, stationed in PORT ARTHUR and MUKDEN. PW returned to JAPAN in '29 and was transferred to 18 Regt in 3 Div at HANOYA. Completed his time there in 1935.

Recalled in Aug '37 and sent to CHINA with 115 Regt being stationed in THYHSIN, SHANGHAI and KALFENG. Discharged in July '39 and returned to JAPAN, joining NISSAN Automobile Co. (See Sec. 8)

Pre SWPA

30 Jul '41 recalled again to 115 Regt 51 Div at TAKASAKI.

Aug '41 115 Regt sent to CANTON in 3 ships, news unknown and unascertained.

Nov '42 PW sailed for JAPAN with ashes of 38 men of 115 Regt and of 190 from other units which PW could not name. Ship proceeded direct to UJIMA.

Dec '42 PW sailed direct to BANGAL, name of vessel unrecalled. 182 Provisional Officers and WO's on board.
